«SMALL PEASANT FARMS AND FARMING HOUSEHOLDS IN WARTIME AND POST-WAR RECONSTRUCTION OF UKRAINE: POLITICAL DIALOGUE»



During the active warfare period, small peasant and farming households demonstrated intense activity, strong capacity, and flexibility in delivering self-produced food to Ukrainians despite broken supply chains and blocked external agricultural export-import channels. Indeed, they supplied most of the potatoes, vegetables and fruits, milk, meat, and eggs to local markets before the war without having adequate state institutional support. The need for fundamental changes in the Ukrainian agricultural policy to improve its friendliness to small-scale agricultural producers has become obvious. Small farmers play a key role in the post-war rebuilding of Ukraine and will continue to do so. Therefore, they require special attention and support coming from the state and society. To this end, the Association of Farmers and Private Landowners (AFLU), the academic community, and the civil society of Ukraine and Europe initiate the Public Forum «Small Peasant Farms and Farming Households in Wartime and Post-War Reconstruction of Ukraine: Political Dialogue».

The purpose of the Forum is to include small farmers' and peasants' problems in the agenda of the President, Government, and Parliament of Ukraine, to establish a political platform for the inclusion of peasant and farming households into the Plan for the Reconstruction of Ukraine as an equal player in Ukraine's food system, to develop and implement further steps for the development of the food system at the local level and the sustainability of the state democratic system. The role and importance of small peasant and farming households in guaranteeing the human right to high-quality and safe domestically produced food, developing local markets, and short agri-food chains will be highlighted with the participation of representatives from the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), the EU Commis-sioner for Agrarian and Rural Development, the European academic community and associations of small farmers and peasants in Europe.

Farmers, Ukrainian and International experts, representatives of state power, and civil society will exchange views and elaborate joint solutions to create a favorable institutional environment in Ukraine, preserve and build the po-tential of the peasant-farming system, and guarantee Ukrainians the constitutional right to domestically produced food.
